Lager

Is a type of beer made from malted barley that is brewed and stored at low temperatures. There are many types of lager; pale lager is the most widely-consumed and commercially available style of beer in the world; Pilsner, Bock, Dortmunder Export and Märzen are all styles of lager.

Pilsner

Created in the Czech republic town of Plzen This style was thought to have been created when the maltster fell asleep at the fires causing it to go out and bringing about this very light crisp beer most mainstream beers we know today are a nouve version of this style.

Abv: 3.5-5.5% | Bitterness: Low to Med

| Colour: Very Light | Serving Temp: 4-7°C

Light grain flavor with a hint of hoppiness and a slight grass aroma

- Great with most lighter foods, chicken, lighter fish (salmon, flathead), Wiesswurst
- Mild Cheddar
- Lemon meringue, fresh berrie

American Pale Ales (APA)

America's spin on an English pale ale, the American pale ale is similar to its English counterpart, but differs due to a brewer's use of American hops, malt, yeast, and water. The American pale ale will generally be cleaner and have less of a caramel malt profile, less body, and often more finishing hops and bitterness. Overall, the American pale ale is refreshing and hoppy with an adequate malt base which balances the beer.

Abv: 4.5-7.5%

| Bitterness: Moderate to High

| Colour: Pale

| Serving Temp: 8-12°C

Floral and hoppy a lot of these beers have a big tropical fruit backing to a nice light beginning with a well rounded bitterness.

- The ultimate footy beer, great with a meat pie or a burger. However it really shines when it is complimented by a hit of spice.
- English cheeses such as a cheddar, the more bitter the beer the higher the age.

Indian Pale Ale (IPA)

This was a time when the British Empire was still in the process of colonizing India, In order to keep troop moral up they decided to send beer to them. Unfortunately, by the time the beer made the arduous journey from England to India it had gone off. But, because hops and alcohol are both natural preservatives they knew that increase the quantities of both would not only make a fuller flavoured beer but keep it from spoiling too.

Abv: 6-8%

| Bitterness: High to Very High

| Colour: Pale to brown

| Serving Temp: 8-12°C

Large bold and full flavoured with big aromas of tropical fruits and a bit alcohol bite these beers are not for the faint of heart.

- Brilliant when match with a nice spicy curry such as a Vindaloo
- A mild inoffensive blue such as gorgonzola

Porters, Stouts, Dark Lagers, Bocks, Ambers, ESB's & IBA's

Porters

Porters originally came about due to poor water conditions in the British empire. When the ship porters were making the arduous trip carrying cargo from the ships up to the town they would stop at the pub on the way and have a beer. This beer was not only a sterile source of water, but had the same nutrients as a loaf of bread.

They are typically made by burning the husk off the malt before adding it to the batch, this gives the beer a coffee/chocolate aroma and a nice bitter taste. Stouts are made in the same way but are typically thicker and heavier hence 'stout'.

Abv: 4.5-10% | Bitterness: low to med
| Colour: Black | Serving Temp: 10-15°C

Porters tend to be quite versatile whilst some may have subtle fruitier tones others may go on to have big rich caramel and coffee tones with a velvet chocolate mouth feel.

- Flemish Stew, Osso Bucco or Barbequed Sausage
- Well aged cheddar or a Tilsit
- Large amounts of chocolate and coffee

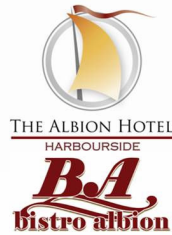

Trappist and Abbey Beers

A Trappist beer is a beer brewed by or under control of Trappist monks. There are a total of 174 Trappist monasteries worldwide; only seven (six in Belgium and one in the Netherlands) produce Trappist beer and are authorized to label their beers with the *Authentic Trappist Product* logo that indicates a compliance to the various rules of the International Trappist Association. There are several different ways that these monasteries make beer, One being a Dubbel, the origin of the dubbel was a beer brewed in the Trappist Abbey of Westmalle in 1856. 'Westmalle Dubbel' was imitated by other breweries, Trappist and commercial, Belgian and worldwide, leading to the emergence of a style.

Abv: 6-8% | Bitterness: very low
| Colour: Light brown | Serving Temp: 10-13°C

'Dubbels' are now understood to be a fairly strong with understated bitterness, fairly heavy body, and a pronounced fruitiness and cereal character.

- Good with a grilled meat and other smokey flavours
- Washed rind abbey cheese
- Bread pudding or milk chocolate

Another being a Tripel, Westmalle Tripel is considered to be the foundation of this beer style, and was developed in the 1930s

Abv: 8-10% | Bitterness: low to med
| Colour: Golden | Serving Temp: 8-10°C

Tripels are quite powerful beers with big fruity tones and great front palate flavor.

- Asparagus, prosciutto and other light but bold foods (if that makes sense)
- A full flavoured fatty cheese like a fromage or brie



Wheat beers (Weizen & Weiss)

There are quite a few beer styles that reside under the greater umbrella of wheat beer. Like stouts, there are too many varieties of wheat beer to cover them properly in a brief beer style profile. So, here is a layman's guide to wheat beers.

What makes a beer a wheat beer? Simply put, a significant quantity of the mash should contain wheat. A typical Hefeweizen contain 30-70% wheat malt and the remainder is regular barley malt, usually a pale variety like Pilsner. Hefeweizens are the first to break the Rheinheitsgebot (german purity law) Though there are many different

styles and sub-styles that can be called wheat beers and they all share similar characteristics.

Abv: 4.5-6.5% | Bitterness: Low
| Colour: Pale and Cloudy | Serving Temp: 4.5-7°C

The presence of yeast in the bottle provides a nice clove and banana flavour without the smack of a lager.

- Great with scallops, sashimi and other light crustacean and fish
- Goat's cheese, feta or and light herbal spread

Rauchbiers

Aroma: Blend of smoke and malt, with a varying balance and intensity. The beechwood smoke character can range from subtle to fairly strong, and can seem smoky, bacon-like, woody, or rarely almost greasy. The malt character can be low to moderate, and be somewhat sweet, toasty, or malty. Hop aroma may be very low to none. Clean, lager character with no fruity esters, diacetyl or DMS.

Appearance: This should be a very clear beer, with a large, creamy, rich, tan- to cream-colored head. Deep amber/light copper to dark brown color.

Lambic

Is a very distinctive type of beer brewed only in the Pajottenland region of Belgium (southwest of Brussels) and in Brussels itself at the Cantillon Brewery and museum. Lambic is now mainly consumed after refermentation, resulting in derived beers such as Geuze or Kriek.^[1]

Unlike conventional ales and lagers, which are fermented by carefully cultivated strains of brewer's yeasts, lambic beer is produced by spontaneous fermentation: it is exposed to the wild yeasts and bacteria that are said to be native to the Senne valley, in which Brussels lies. It is this unusual process which gives the beer its distinctive flavour: dry, vinous, and cidery, usually with a sour aftertaste.

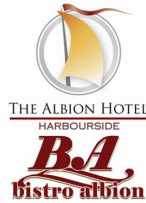
